Uses Facebook integration to share notes and reviews with friends




- Motivation & Market Demand


1. What's your gender? (16 responses)




2. What's your age group? (16 responses)




3. When vacationing do you normally carry and use a smartphone?




4. Would you be more likely to take a tour with a local tour guide or large company?



5. Would you feel comfortable taking a tour with a local you haven't met before?




6. What information about a guide would make you more comfortable taking a tour with him/her? (Check all that apply)



7. When traveling what aspects about a stranger lead to being friends?




8. What aspects of information about the tour itself are you concerned about when deciding on a tour? (Please rate each on a scale of 1-5)

Encouraging Contribution

Goal setting - Motivate tour guides to become best guide in area. Identify local gem tours for tour takers.

Authority/Relationship - Send email from tour guide to tour takers. Automatically do it with one click.

Liking - Base recommendations on similarity between profiles of tour takers and tour guides.

Privileges/Tangible Rewards - If you give a tour, you can take a free tour in another city the first time. If you give 5 different tours, you can get another free one. Tours cannot be poorly rated.

Reputation - Ratings for both tour takers and tour guides. Like eBay and Airbnb.



Ideas for Newcomers

- Find social community interested in traveling. Introduce application and ask some of them to be tour guides.
- Allow highly ranked AirBnb hosts to be tour guides without completing any extra steps.
- Have new tour guides provide answer to question about city in question or neighborhood.
- Provide people with referral links to give to their friends who may be good guides.
- Give points to local guides to use for discounts when traveling.





